



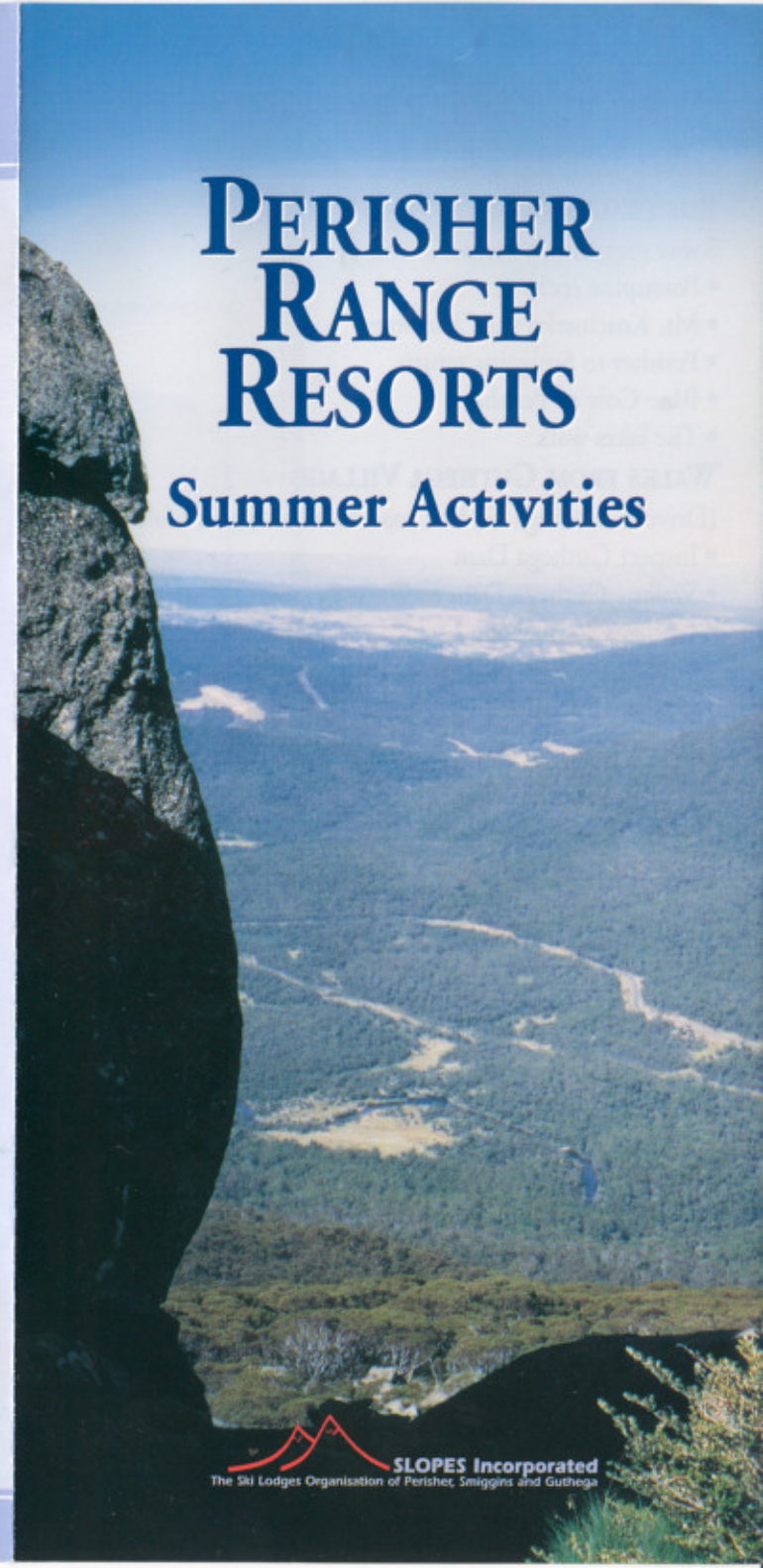
ACTIVITIES FURTHER AFIELD

- Yarrangobilly Caves and Visitor Centre - this is well worth the visit. Guided and self-guided cave tours, thermal pool and picnic facilities. 109 km from Cooma the trip is scenic and passes through many historical areas, including the old gold mining town of Kiandra.
- Lookout for emus along the way!
- The Snowy Scheme is on display at
 - (I) Murray 1 Inflowstation, Khancoban- learn about water & the environment at this new interactive visitor facility open 7 days.
 - (II) The Power Point, Tumut 3 power station or
 - (III) Tumut 2 Underground power station where you can do a 1 km underground journey.
- Historical interest - Stroll around an historical village at Berridale Bush Village, open Tuesday to Sunday. (6456 3350)
- Eucumbene trout farm & double GG trail rides, open 7 days (02 6456 8866)
- Wine tasting and restaurant overlooking the Snowy River at the Snowy River Winery 14 km from Berridale.
- Llama farm just before Cooma, see Llamas and alpacas in the paddocks, drive a buggy pulled by a Llama.
- Crafts at Past Times country craft centre near Cooma. -great crafts and displays, as well as tea rooms.
